Requirements for NDTN Membership:

NDTN membership is open to any organisation or individual who is willing to participate in NDTN activities and contribute to the promotion of Deceased Donor Organ Transplantation. Institutions will be accredited for membership of the Network subject to fulfillment of the following criteria, approval by the Executive Council/Committee, and payment of one-time joining fee of Rs 5,000/-

An Institution Member shall be an association, company, firm or body of persons in public or private sector including Governmental organizations with a written constitution and appropriate registration having health related issues and/or social service as one of their primary area of concern.

Should any corporate house wish to join the network as a part of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) or to promote the deceased donor transplantation programme of the network. The Executive Committee may invite them to become Corporate Members. The annual membership fee will be Rs. 50,000/- only or as may be decided by the Network from time to time. Corporate Members will have voting rights.

Foreign institutions, individuals and corporates can also become members subject to the same criteria and rules and responsibilities as for Indian institutions, individuals and corporates, with the exception that they will not have voting rights.



Responsibilities of NDTN Members:

Attend and actively participate in the NDTN meetings and related events. Give continuous input to the NDTN work and ongoing projects, completing commitments to agreed deadlines.

Report on activities, achievements and developments to the NDTN secretariat for posting on the NDTN web site and/or for use in other NDTN informational and promotional purposes.
